		6	Original + copy	A passport with a validity of at least 12 months. Please make sure your passport has at least 2 double spare pages to affix the visa. Copy of bio-data pages (this includes the signature page), and copy of previous visa Schengen (if applicable)
		7	2 sets of copies	For Indonesian/Timor Leste nationals: copy of ID card For foreigners : residence permit: KITAS, KITAP, Visa Sosial Budaya, etc.
		8	Original + copy	Official copy of marriage certificate (with Apostille), issued < 6 months If issued in Indonesia: Buku Nikah or its legalized copy (for muslims) or Kutipan Akte Pernikahan (for other religions) See here for the procedure of Apostille.
		9	Original + copy	Divorce certificate or death certificate of previous spouse in case of previous marriage (if applicable) (with Apostille). If previous marriage was not muslim, Kutipan Akte Perceraian. If previous marriage was muslim, an Akta Cerai. For death certificate, Kutipan Akte Kematian. See here for the procedure of Apostille.

		11	Original + copy	Medical certificate attesting absence of diseases that might endanger public health. The form must be signed and stamped by one of the designated doctors and is valid only 6 months from date of issue. See list of doctors . 		12	2 sets of copies	Belgian Residence card of the spouse (B-, C-, D-, F- of F+-card)
		13	2 sets of copies	Proof that spouse has a health insurance policy covering medical costs in Belgium for him / her and the family (mutualiteit/mutuelle)
		14	2 sets of copies	Proof of sufficient accommodation in Belgium Proof of registration of the rental contract; or proof of purchase
		15	2 sets of copies	Proof of spouse's regular and sufficient means of subsistence Attestation of family composition + salary slips of the last 12 months / last income tax statement for professionals / pensions / ... ¹
		16	Original	Handling fee for Visa D: see the pdf in consular tariffs (handling fee is not refundable in case of withdrawing application or refusal)

		17	Original + copy	Official copy of birth certificate (Kutipan Akte Kelahiran) issued < 6 months (with Apostille) See here for Apostille.
		18	Original + copy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Death certificate (Kutipan Akte Kematian) translated and legalized, of the passed away parent; OR - If the parents are divorced and the applicant has the full custody of the child, the court decision regarding the custody, with Apostille; OR - If the parents are divorced and have a shared custody, the court decision regarding the custody and parental consent from the biological father/mother, made by a notary, with Apostille.
